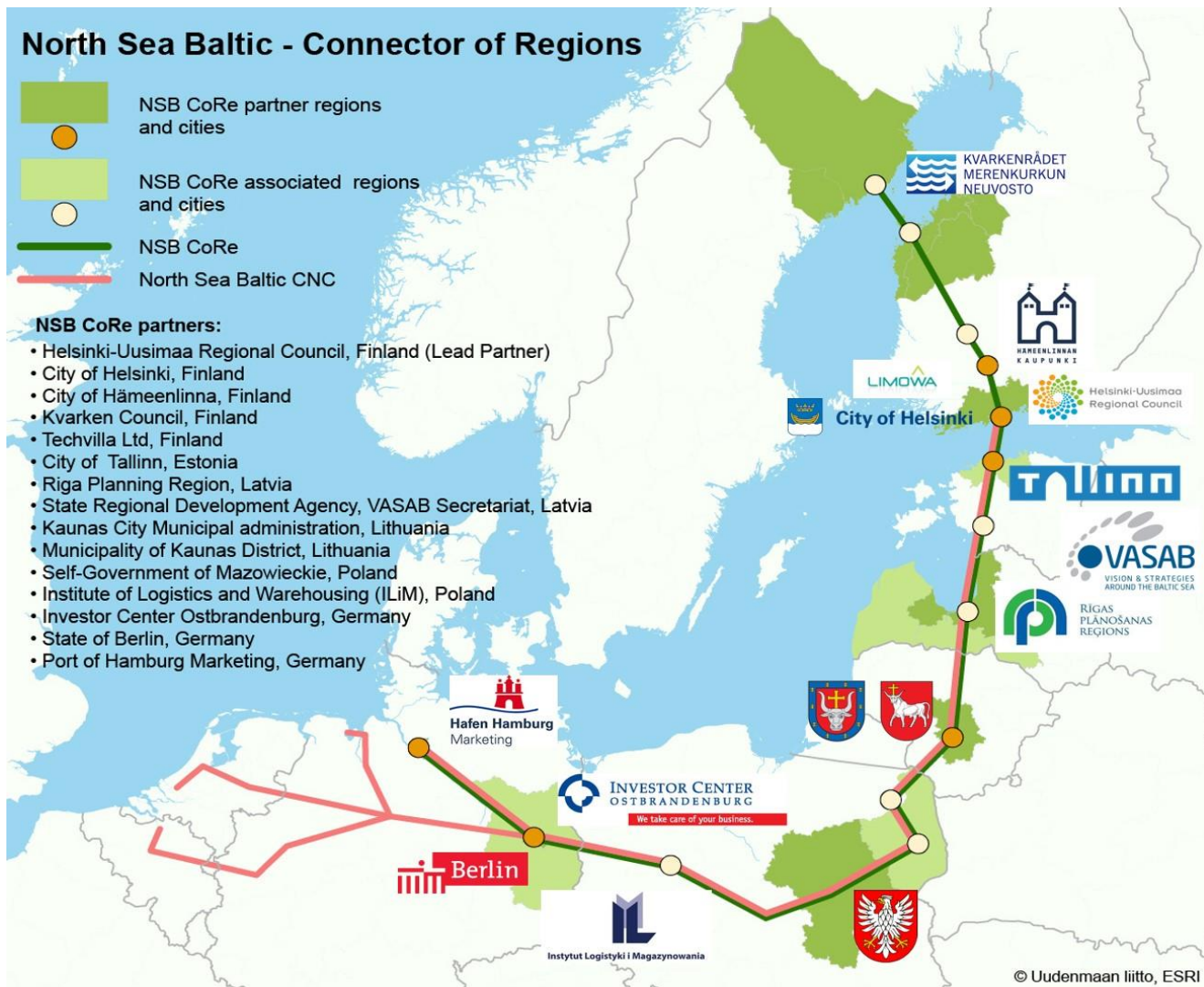
Aims of NSB CoRe

Improve international accessibility of urban nodes and their access routes

- Connect the North Sea – Baltic TEN-T Core Network Corridor to its catchment area.
- Focus on freight and passenger transport.

Dialogue: EU – regional – local level

- Implement the TEN-T Regulation from a regional development perspective
- Facilitation between local, national and EU-level decision-makers.



NSB CoRe Activities and Outputs

LOGISTICS

Development of logistics services to serve **future demand** and **modal shift**.

Output: Improved interconnectivity and interoperability for freight

LONG-DISTANCE COMMUTING

MaaS development on **cross-border** commuting corridors:

FI-EE, Baltics, DE-PL

Output: Smart mobility concepts and passenger service development in urban nodes

SPATIAL PLANNING

Transport development and spatial planning **combined** into one process.

Output: Joint **transnational** spatial vision on regional development, logistics and mobility

BRANDING AND COMMUNITY BUILDING

Rail Baltica process from stakeholders' view

Output: North Sea Baltic Growth Strategy

BSR Access – Project platform



Led by Helsinki-Uusimaa Regional Council, BSR Access is a Project Platform that combines several EUSBSR Flagships and other projects:

- Enhanced corridor development in BSR
- First and Last Mile Access to the CNCs in the BSR
- BSR Connectivity Forum

Supporters of BSR Access include three TEN-T Coordinators and EUSBSR Coordinators of PA Transport and HA Spatial planning, and CPMR Baltic Sea Commission.
